Introduction

PRINCE2® (Projects IN Controlled Environments, Version2) is a structured method for effective Project Management. Developed by the UK Government, the PRINCE2® method is internationally accepted as the leading “best practice” Project Management approach and is widely used in the private and public sectors, both in the UK and internationally.

The course covers the 2017 version and provides delegates with a solid grounding in the techniques, processes and tools of PRINCE2® and Project Management methodology.

This is the three-day approach to gaining the Foundation qualification. It is an intense course that will require delegates to prepare thoroughly and be prepared for evening work throughout the course. The course includes the Foundation examination and prepares delegates for the Practitioner course should they wish to move to that level.
